On October 15, 2008, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) lowered the National Ambient Air Quality Lead Standard from a quarterly average of 1.5 µg/m<sup>3</sup> to a rolling three-month average of 0.15 µg/m<sup>3</sup>, effective October 2009. The method of collecting the samples did not change. All results are below the current standard for the Site of 1.5 ug/m<sup>3</sup> and below the revised NAAQS standard of 0.15 ug/m<sup>3</sup>.
