

Co-Located Lead Sample Result for Non-Working Hours

Week of June 22, 2009

On October 15, 2008, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) lowered the National Ambient Air Quality Lead Standard from a quarterly average of 1.5 µg/m³ to a rolling three-month average of 0.15 µg/m³, effective October 2009. The method of collecting the samples did not change. The current standard for the Site is 1.5 ug/m³.
